Make a Joyful Noise is a celebration of life and healing. We solicit from you ethereal and spiritual art, in the low key values. Color value scale from 1 to 5.

As a symbol of hope, we are decorating the Center theatre with origami cranes. We invite everyone to fold and string cranes for the show. For instructions, visit the Art Exhibits page on CarrollwoodCenter.org

This will be a juried/judged fine art exhibition organized by the Carrollwood Cultural Center. The competition is open to all artists who reside in the Tampa Bay area. **2D and 3D fine art in any color in value range from 1 to 5. All media is eligible so long as it can be hung on the wall or stand on its own on a shelf and fits the weight and size constraints.** All work must be original. No prints!

ENTRY AND FEES: Submission fee: \$30 up to a 3-piece limit depending on size. \$25 for members of the Center or North Tampa Arts League. \$20 for Hillsborough County Art Educators.

ART DELIVERY: Artists must deliver their work to the Center on Wednesday, September 1, 2010 between 2 and 5:30 p.m. All work must remain on exhibit until September 30, 2010.

JUDGING: The entries will be juried by the judge and artists will be notified which pieces are accepted into the show.

SHOW BREAKDOWN AND ART

PICKUP: Pickup is September 30, 2010 between 2 and 5:30 p.m. Work that is not picked up will become the property of the Carrollwood Cultural Center. No storage is available. **If you are unable to make the pickup, please arrange for someone to pick up your work for you.**

SALES: The Cultural Center will encourage sales by putting customers in touch with the artists. A donation to the Center of 15% to 20% of the sale price is strongly suggested by the Curator. The Center is a non-profit organization that operates on memberships, classes and donations. Make sure your phone number and other information is on your piece.

If a piece of art is sold while on display, it must stay in place until the exhibition is over. **Failure to comply will result in inability to show at the Center for 6 months.**

AWARDS: Ribbons and:

Best in Show – \$200

1st Place – \$150

2nd Place – \$75

3rd Place – \$50

4 Honorable Mentions – \$20

RULES: All artwork must be original and not a previous award winner (ribbon or cash prize) at the Center. No teacher-assisted or class-generated art will be accepted. No reproductions and no nudes.

SIZE LIMITS: 3D work such as sculpture and hand-built pottery may not exceed 18”H x 12”D x 10”W. Bas relief may not exceed 15lbs. 2D work may not exceed 40” in any direction, including frame, and be no smaller than 16 x 20”. All 2D work must be framed and wired for hanging. Gallery-wrapped canvas is acceptable but must be painted around the edges with no visible staples. **NO SAWTOOTH HANGERS.**

Works will not be accepted without proper framing and wiring.

ARTIST RECEPTION: Reception will be Friday, September 10, from 6 to 9 p.m. at the Center, 4537 Lowell Rd, 813-269-1310.

LIABILITY: All reasonable precautions will be taken to ensure protection of submitted work. No liability can be assumed by the juror, sponsors or personnel connected to the exhibition for damages or loss of work. Each artist will be required to sign an indemnity form at the time of submission. The form will be in effect for the calendar year of 2010.
